- **When to call 999:**
  - · When there is a danger to life or people are injured.
  - · When someone is using or threatening violence.
  - · When there is a crime in progress.
  - · When serious damage is or could be caused to a property.
  - · If there is a road traffic collision when someone is hurt or there is a danger to other road users.
  - · When an immediate police response is necessary
